There's Nothing Shocking About Why Shock Devices Can Be Harmful to Pets

Studies show that shock devices are unnecessary and have the potential to be very dangerous.

Shock Devices:

- ✓ Suppress behaviors instead of addressing underlying causes
- ✓ Can create behavioral problems
- ✓ Can malfunction causing serious injury
- ✓ Jeopardizes your pet's health, welfare, and your relationship



"The behaviors for which people wish to use shock in dogs are those that annoy humans. These behaviors are either signals or nonspecific signs of underlying distress. The question should be, are we doing harm when we use shock to extinguish behaviors, some of which may be normal? If one is considering the mechanism of cellular learning, the answer must be yes."
